### CONTRACT OF AGREEMENT FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF TWENTY-THREE (23) PERSONNEL FOR SECURITY SERVICES

This Contract of Agreement is entered into by and between:



**SAN FRANCISCO WATER DISTRICT**, a government-owned and controlled corporation, existing under the laws of Presidential Decree 198 with an office address at Osmeña Street, Brgy. 2, San Francisco, Agusan del Sur, represented by its **General Manager**, **ELMER T. LUZON**, herein represented as the "**PROCURING ENTITY**";

-and-

PHILGUARD SECURITY SERVICES, INC., a private entity duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with its principal office and business address at Lot 22, Blk 3 Ph7 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Dunkin Donut Bldg., Ecoland Subd.,Brgy 74-A, Davao City, Davao Del Sur, represented by its **General Manager**, **OLIVER B. DERECHO**, of legal age, Filipino, married herein referred to as the "SECURITY SERVICE PROVIDER";

WHEREAS, upon the invitation of the PROCURING ENTITY, the SERVICE PROVIDER submitted a bid for the Procurement of Twenty-three (23) Personnel for Security Services to safeguard and protect the properties and facilities of the PROCURING ENTITY against theft, robbery, pilferage, arson, vandalism and other unlawful act of strangers, employees and other persons within the premise of Lapag, Karaos, Alegria, Sumugbong, Bayugan II, Ormaca Reservoir Sites and SFWD Main Building Office in the amount of FIVE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED NINETY-NINE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE PESOS AND 31/100 (PHP 5,599,659.31);

WHEREAS, the PROCURING ENTITY accepted the bid of the SECURITY SERVICE PROVIDER through SFWD Bids and Awards Committee Resolution No. 2024-04-093 dated April 2, 2024, which was approved by the General Manager of the PROCURING ENTITY. The latter has issued a NOTICE OF AWARD dated April 17, 2024, the Security Service Provider has conformed and posted a Performance Bond as stipulated in Section 37.2.1 of RA 9184 of the Revised IRR of 2016;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in consideration of the above-mentioned premises, the Procuring Entity and the Security Service Provider hereby agree as follows:

- 1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.

In consideration of the payment to be made by the **PROCURING ENTITY** for the sum of **FIVE** MILLION FIVE HUNDRED NINETY-NINE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE PESOS AND 31/100 (PHP 5,599,659.31) to the SECURITY SERVICE PROVIDER. The SECURITY SERVICE PROVIDER hereby covenants to start delivering the twenty-three (23) duly licensed security guards on May 26, 2024. The activation of this contract shall take effect from May 26, 2024 to May 25, 2025, unless sooner terminated for a cause. After the expiration of this contract and no new contract has been made or issued by the PROCURING ENTITY or the result of the next bidding is not yet issued, if one is conducted, this contract shall be deemed extended on a month-to-month basis, to such period as may be allowed by law.

### OBLIGATIONS OF PROCURING ENTITY AND SECURITY SERVICE PROVIDER

- a) The PROCURING ENTITY agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the Bidding.
- b) The **PROCURING ENTITY** or its representative shall have the right to inspect or test assigned firearms, security guards, paraphernalia, and other assigned gadgets to check their conformity to the contract specifications at no extra cost to the **PROCURING ENTITY**.
- c) The PROCURING ENTITY shall pay to the SECURITY SERVICE PROVIDER at the cost stipulated in the Contract Price, payable semi-monthly in Philippine Currency and of the following schedules:

- d) The SECURITY SERVICE PROVIDER shall submit a billing statement to the PROCURING ENTITY on a semi-monthly basis and shall attach the following documents to ensure conformity of the obligations due to the guard and the Philippine Government in particular;
  - Previous Month's proof of payment to SSS
  - b. Previous Month's proof of payment to PhilHealth
  - c. Previous Month's proof of payment to Pag-Ibig Fund
  - d. Pay slips of the Security Personnel of the previous month
  - e. Personnel Performance Audit Report per semester which includes a checklist to validate job description and furnish the same to the management
  - f. Submission of attendance and declaration of the toolbox meeting/ orientation conducted by a representative of the agency each month.
- e) Upon request of the **PROCURING ENTITY**, the **SECURITY SERVICE PROVIDER** shall replace without question a security guard who may be found undesirable, principally, but not limited to the following causes: bad faith, malfeasance or misfeasance, disorderly or abusive conduct, unimproved attitude, dishonesty, excessive tardiness or absences, negligence of duty, or who may have violated the rules and regulation and policies of the **PROCURING ENTITY**, as well as other laws, ordinances, rules, and regulations governing the conduct of its operation.
- f) The PROCURING ENTITY shall be informed in writing at least three (3) days before replacing any security personnel and the replacement shall be subject to the approval of the PROCURING ENTITY.
- g) The 24-hour guarding system and the duties and responsibilities of the guard as stipulated in the Technical Specifications shall be strictly followed. The **SECURITY SERVICE PROVIDER** shall supervise the overall performance of the guard by providing personnel to supervise or inspect regularly on a semi-monthly basis. Aside from the regular inspections, there will be surprise inspections at the discretion of the **SECURITY SERVICE PROVIDER**.
- h) The guards are expected to perform at the highest level of efficiency and effectiveness, arwell-trained and in good grooming, and shall perform duties from Monday to Sunday including Holidays. To properly carry out its duties and functions under this agreement, the SECURITY SERVICE PROVIDER shall be guided by the instructions issued by the PROCURING ENTITY through its designated representative, and security guards' duties shall be performed in accordance with said instructions which the PROCURING ENTITY may at its discretion alter or amend by from time to time.
- i) The SECURITY SERVICE PROVIDER shall be responsible for the loss or damage that may be incurred upon the properties and installations of the PROCURING ENTITY as indicated hereto provided that such loss or damage is due to the negligence or fault in the lawful performance of security duties by the assigned guards and is brought to the attention of the SECURITY SERVICE PROVIDER or the guard on duty in writing not more than forty-eight (48) hours after its occurrence. Negligence, fault, or omission shall be conclusively presumed on the part of the guards in the event that a door, window, or any part of the building where the loss or damage occurs has been forcibly opened. In case of disagreement, the parties agree to create an arbitration committee for each party and a third party to be selected by them, preferably from the police agency of the locality, who will decide the controversy.
- j) Subject to the provision of the Special Conditions of the Contract and Technical Specifications, if the SECURITY SERVICE PROVIDER fails to satisfactorily comply or perform the services within the period(s) specified in this contract, the PROCURING ENTITY shall

- without prejudice to its remedies under this contract and other applicable laws, deduct from the Contract Price, as liquidated damages, a sum equivalent to one-tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the cost of unperformed portion for every day of delay.
- k) Further, the **SECURITY SERVICE PROVIDER** shall deliver the following Logistical Requirements under the Technical Specification of the bid documents within thirty (30) calendar days upon receipt of the Notice to Proceed:

Security guard with a non-regulation haircut, wearing beard/mustache or in improper uniform, non-wearing of or un-shined buckle, badges or shoes

Deduction from billing of 350.00 for the first offense and 500.00 for the second offense and for the third offense removal of a guard from Procuring Entity upon written notice of the latter to the Agency.

#### AMENDMENT:

m) The **PROCURING ENTITY** at its sole discretion may increase or decrease this number of guards depending upon the security situation or in the exigency of service by giving the **SECURITY SERVICE PROVIDER** at least three (3) days before written request.

### ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION

n) Should any dispute related to this contract and/or the right of the Parties arise, the same be submitted for mutual consultations, mediations, and arbitration, in the order of the application.

### TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

o) Both parties have the option to terminate the contract applicable to both parties based on the Philippine Government Procurement Reform Act and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, GPPB Guidelines or its issuances, and other applicable Philippine Laws. The grounds and the Procedure for termination shall be in accordance with ANNEX "I" of
